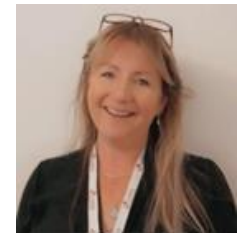
**Miss McTear - LSTA**

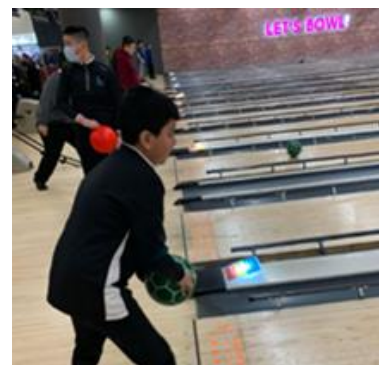
We do lots of activities inside and outside of school.

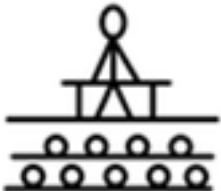
